

**Ovulation Induction for Couples with Infertility  
Position Statement  
American Academy of FertilityCare Professionals**

The position of the Academy is that treatments with ovulation induction for infertility should be reserved for couples in ***religious or civil*** marriages, ***between a man and a woman***, consistent with our Code of Ethics. There is abundant literature to support the premise that children who are raised in homes by married parents experience significant psychosocial health advantages over children who are raised in homes by cohabitating adults. Therefore, ovulation induction prescribed by physicians for couples with infertility should be reserved for those couples who will provide proper, nurturing home environments in which to raise children.

The Academy continues to affirm the belief that all women, single or married, are entitled to the health information and self-knowledge that is provided by the Creighton Model FertilityCare System.
